ANNUAL GRANT PROGRAM

CAEF had a record Spring 2022 Grant cycle awarding \$26,513 in grants to 22 district education initiatives with full or partial funding. This supplemental support provided Centennial students with enhanced educational experiences at all levels of education. 2022 grants awarded:

NEW for 2023 - CAEF Grants Awarded Twice per Year

CAEF is updating the annual grant process and awards will be given twice per year starting 2023. Grant applications will be open and accepted throughout the year allowing applicants the opportunity to apply at any time. A new funding cycle means educators can plan application timing based on their educational curriculum and program needs that same year. A committee made up of members of the community will review grants in spring and fall.

The first grant review will be considered for applications received on or before March 15, 2023 with award announcements made in April. The second review will be any applications submitted on or before October 15th with an award announcement in November/December. 2022 Year-In-Review

POWER OF CENTENNIAL (POC)

The POC community members pooled their donations and awarded \$3,176 in spring 2022 toward six different programs. Since 2014 the program awarded a grand total of \$25,759.

The POC underwent a few changes over the summer of 2022. The Chairperson stepped down and the role was not filled for a Fall 2022 meeting. After a membership meeting with many discussions, and no Chairperson taking the leadership role, it was concluded the program will fold into the new CAEF Grant cycles starting in 2023.

More than \$47,000 was administered by the foundation to 50 graduating seniors of Centennial High School on May 23, 2022. CAEF hosted a reception for recipients, parents, and donors which was followed by the CHS scholarship award ceremony. CAEF directly funded \$16,000 to seniors including a newly created scholarship honoring former foundation president, Jan Kreminski, for his 19 years of service and leadership.

2022 CAEF EVENTS

CAEF Annual Gala (April) - Our 2022 Gala night was all about continuing our mission of "Supporting Education to build a Strong Community" and gathering for our first "back in person" Gala since 2019. Saturday, April 9, 2022 was a fun evening of 195 guests and exhibited a splendid showing of generosity. More than \$65,000 in commitments were made by gala attendees, sponsors, Fund-the-Need bidders and the online auction.

A few event highlights include:

- The LIVE auction included six different experiences bringing in more than \$11,900.
- 115 bids were made during our online silent auction which collected around \$4,000.
- Over \$21,000 was raised for Fund-A-Need supporting "Social and Emotional Learning", a priority for the district to enhance social and emotional learning programs and curriculum throughout the district.
- 13 CHS National Honor Society student volunteers donated their time during the event and their assistance was invaluable.
